

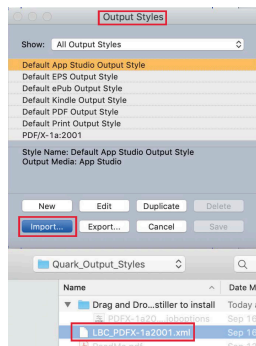
How to Install and use Quark PDF Output Styles

There are two methods for creating PDFs in Quark. Both Windows and Macintosh versions of Quark use the same methods.

1. PDF export method
2. Create PostScript for later distilling

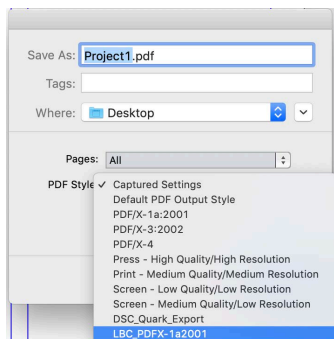
Import Lakeside Book's output style file

1. To import Lakeside Book's output style, you will need to download an xml file accompanying this ReadMe file.
2. Go to the Edit > Output Styles... option in Quark.
3. Click on the Import button. Select the appropriate xml file called LBC_PDFX-1a2001.xml in the folder you downloaded, Select it and click on the Open button to complete the import. Once imported it will now show in the output styles window. *You only have to import this file once for each Quark installation.*



Export Method

1. To create a PDF file, first open your Quark file, then go to File > Export > Layout as PDF...
2. Name the file. Select the imported PDF Style from the popup menu and choose your destination folder. Then click on the Save button.
3. Send the resulting PDF to Lakeside Book.



Create PostScript

1. Change the default PDF preferences to the option "Create PostScript for Later Distilling". *Warning: Do not change this preference if you are going to use the export method. You will only need to change this preference one, not each time you make a new PostScript file.*
2. To create a PostScript file, first open your Quark file, then go to File > Export > Layout as PDF...
3. Name the file. Select the imported PDF Style from the popup menu and choose your destination folder. Then click on the Save button.
4. To finish the process of making a PDF file, use Distiller to convert this PostScript file to a PDF. *Install the PDFX-1a2001_LBC.joboptions file from this package into Distiller before converting PostScript to PDF - to ensure that Distiller will support new Quark features.*
